



EVERGREENS

DESCRIPTION

ARBORVITAE

DARK GREEN

ZONE 3-7

An upright, cone shaped, narrow evergreen with flattened sprays of dense, deep green foliage and good winter color.

EMERALD GREEN

ZONE 3-8

A narrow, pyramidal evergreen with dense, emerald green foliage that holds its color throughout winter.

A slow growing, low maintenance globe-shaped evergreen shrub with fine, bright gold spring foliage

WOODWARD GLOBE ZONE 3-7

Woodward arborvitae is a smaller evergreen with showy rich deep green foliage which holds its color well throughout winter.

GOLDEN GLOBE

ZONE 3-8

Golden Globe Arborvitae has a nice, round globe shape that doesn't get out of control. Its dense foliage is a golden yellow on the outside with a bright green interior

GREEN GIANT

ZONE 5-8

The Green Giant is a large evergreen tree cloaked in thick, soft, dark green foliage from top to bottom. This variety is one of the fastest growing Arborvitae with a growth rate of 2-4 feet a year.

LITTLE GIANT GLOBE

ZONE 3-8

Little Giant Globe Arborvitae is a slow growing, globeshaped evergreen with soft, rich dark green foliage which holds its color all year long.

MR. BOWLING BALL

ZONE 3-8


Mr. Bowling Ball is a unique, compact, perfectly global Arborvitae. Its soft, fine-textured foliage retains a rich green color all year.


NOTHERN SPIRE

NEW ZONE 3-8

Upright, dense, columnar growing evergreen with lustrous, rich dark green foliage in the spring and summer. Fall foliage turns a russet-red.

NEW ZONE 3-7

This fast growing evergreen has a columnar habit, perfect for adding color and concealment, all while being very low-maintenance.

RHEINGOLD

NEW ZONE 3-7

An evergreen shrub in the cypress family. As a young shrub, it has a dense globose form with golden-yellow adolescent foliage in summer.

TECHNY ZONE 3-8

A dwarf conifer which is primarily valued in the landscape for its distinctively pyramidal habit of growth. It has dark green evergreen foliage. The scalelike sprays of foliage remain dark green throughout the winter.

YELLOW RIBBON

ZONE 3-7

Is a very distinctive evergreen with a narrow habit, Its showy, dense golden yellow foliage maintains color throughout the year.

FALSECYPRESS

GOLDEN MOP

ZONE 4-8

A ground-hugging mound that is truly mop-like, with stringy leaves that color best in full sun.

FIR

CONCOLOR

70NF 4-7

Concolor Fir is a large, narrow evergreen with a domeshaped crown and silver soft green foliage.

FRASER ZONE 4-7

Fraser Fir is a tall evergreen that has short, dark-green needles with silver undersides. Commonly used as Christmas trees.





















ZONE 3-8

Soft, feathery evergreen foliage graces a strong, straight pyramidal silhouette. This tree grows into a pyramidal shape supported by one strong central trunk. Short, dark green needles are grayish on the underside.

JUNIPER

BLUE ARROW

ZONE 4-9

An improved selection with tight, bright blue foliage and a very narrow, upright form. Perfect as a tall, narrow screen where space is limited.

BLUE POINT UPRIGHT

ZONE 4-9

Hardy and fast growing juniper with a pyramidal habit and dense, blue-green foliage.

BLUE RUG

ZONE 3-9

Blue Rug Juniper is a very flat-growing form with trailing branches which display silver-blue needles.

BLUE STAR

ZONE 4-8

Blue Star Juniper is a slow-growing, low, rounded squat plant about as broad as it is high with rich silvery blue foliage.

OLD GOLD

Old Gold Juniper displays beautiful bronze-gold foliage which retains its color through winter.

PROCUMBENS NANA

ZONE 4-9

A ground hugging Juniper that provides a dense mound of branches that radiate from the center. New growth is bright green turning bluish green.

RED CEDAR

ZONE 3-9

A small tree with a short trunk and irregular, pyramidal crown. Dwarf or compact forms of this juniper are used as ornamentals.

SEA GREEN

ZONE 4-9

Sea Green grows as a compact spreader with fountainlike, arching branches. Its upright growth with arching branches is a very distinct trait of this variety.



JUNIPER

SKY ROCKET UPRIGHT

ZONE 4-9

Sky Rocket Juniper is likely to be the narrowest juniper available. Known for its tall, columnar growth habit and silvery - blue foliage.

SPARTAN

ZONE 4-9

Spartan Juniper Trees are a densely branched evergreen Juniper with a naturally pyramidal growth habit. The green foliage stays consistent year-round and requires little to no maintenance once established.

PINE

AUSTRIAN

ZONE 4-8

A handsome evergreen tree with a densely branched conical form when young that becomes umbrella-shaped with age. Needles are long and dark green.

MUGHO

Mugho Pine is a hardy, dwarf evergreen with branching, upright stems which are evenly covered in 2 inch long, deep green needles.

ZONE 3-7

ZONE 2-8

This is a fast growing, long lived conifer with a conical to rounded crown. Green needle like leaves are in fascicles of three and 5-10 in long.

WHITE

White Pine is a pryamidal evergreen tree in youth, becoming more irregular with age. Its soft, thin needles are bluish-green and its bark is grayish-green.

SPRUCE

BABY BLUE SPRUCE

ZONE 3-7

A shimmering blue evergreen tree, with a dense habit, full stout branches, and elegant silvery-blue needles, a tree of great color which is retained throughout the year.

BIRDS NEST

ZONE 2-8

Dense, spreading, broad plant of regular growth; usually a depression in center that gives rise to its name. Its foliage is a fabulous blue-green.

BLACK HILLS

ZONE 2-8

Black Hills Spruce a shapely evergreen tree noted for its dark green foliage and conical form. Great for windbreaks, privacy screens and accent planting.




































SPRUCE

COLORADO BLUE

ZONE 2-8

Colorado Blue Spruce is a pryamidal shaped evergreen with some variation of bluish-green foliage. Excellent as a specimen, hedge or windbreak.

DWARF ALBERTA

70NF 2-8

This natural dwarf becomes broadly conical with time; the foliage is bright green, densely set and the needles radiate around the stem.

DWARF ALBERTA SPIRAL

NEW ZONE 2-8

This natural dwarf becomes broadly conical with time; the foliage is bright green, densely set and the needles radiate around the stem. Sheared into a spiral form.

NORWAY

ZONE 2-8

Pyramidal shaped evergreen tree with dense, dark green foliage and sweeping branches. Largest and fastest growing of the spruce varieties.

YEW

DENSIFORMIS

Densiformis Yew is a dense, shrub like form, twice as wide as high with bright green foliage.

HICKS

ZONE 4-7

Excellent evergreen shrub for tall hedges, displaying glossy dark green foliage.

BROAD LEAF EVERGREENS AZALEA

ASST. EVERGREEN VARIETIES

ZONE 5-8

Very hardy evergreen shrub with vibrant colored flowers on vigorous upright plants. Its shiney, dark green foliage turns burgundy in the fall.

BOXWOOD

GREEN MOUTAIN

ZONE 4-9

Upright form boxwood with small green leaves. Makes an excellent low maintenance hedge.

GREEN VELVET

ZONE 4-9

Rounded, full-bodied, slow growing with small dark green leaves. Very hardy boxwood with good winter color.

WINTER GEM

ZONE 5-9

Rounded, full-bodied, slow growing with small dark green shinny leaves. Very hardy boxwood with good winter color.

EUONYMUS

MOONSHADOW

ZONE 4-9

Compact, low growing evergreen shrub with vibrant foliage. Its variegated leaves are dark olive-green blotched with muted yellow.

HOLLY

BLUE PRINCE

ZONE 5-9

Broad, pyramidal evergreen shrub with glossy blue-green foliage. A pollinator for Blue Princess.

BLUE PRINCESS

ZONE 5-9

Broad and shrubby evergreen with abundant dark red fruit and lusterous dark blue-green foliage. Needs Blue Prince for pollination.

COMBINATION

ZONE 5-9

Blue Prince and Blue Princess, always assured berries. Male and female plant in one pot eliminating the need for a pollinator.

PIERIS JAPONICA

MOUNTAIN FIRE

ZONE 5-9

Beautiful firey red new growth mixtures to deep green. A prolife producer of broad drooping white flower clusters.

RHODODENDRON

ASSORTED H-1 VARIETIES

ZONE 4-8

Evergreen flowering shrub, taller than azaleas and have large, leathery leaves. Large flower clusters are born at the end of the branches in early spring, primarily shades of white, pink, red and purple.

PJM

Bright pinkish-lavender flowers bloom in the spring against dark green foliage which turns plum color in the fall.

PJM ELITE

ZONE 4-8

This hardy evergreen shrub is considered to be the most vigorous and upright growing of the PJM clones. Bright pinkish-lavender flowers bloom in the spring against dark green foliage which turns plum color in the fall.







ZONE 2-7

Panicles of fragrant, soft pink, single flowers bloom in early summer. Its dark green foliage turns yellowishgreen in the fall.

JOSEE

ZONE 3-8

This lilac is a repeat-blooming hybrid Chinese lilac with beautiful fragrant blooms on a compact, rounded bush. The abundant blossoms are a bright, lilac-pink, with the rich perfume only lilacs can bring. It blooms not only in spring, but in summer and fall too!

Panicles of fragrant, single red-purple flowers bloom late spring backed by bright green foliage.

MINNESOTA SNOWFLAKE

ZONE 4-8

Multi stemmed deciduous shrub with upright arching branches. Profuse white flowers are double and very fragrant. Blooms begin in late spring and last up to 4 weeks.

NINEBARK

CENTER GLOW

ZONE 3-7

This unique Ninebark has foliage that emerges yellow green but matures into bright, deep red that last all season long. White flowers bloom in spring to add interest to this fast growing shrub.

ZONE 3-7 DIABLO

The deep purple foliage of this versatile shrub makes it a standout in the garden. A great dense hedge or screen. Profuse creamy-white flowers in summer. Foliage can become green in high heat.

ZONE 3-7 LEMON CANDY®

Foliage emerges bright yellow and matures to chartreuse in summer. Clusters of tiny, white flowers decorate this dwarf shrub in late spring.

A Beautiful columnar Physocarpus that combines deep purple foliage with a tight upright habit. The pink flower clusters appear in spring and provide food for pollinators. The purple dissected leaves maintain their dark color all summer, taking on reddish hues in fall.

ZONE 2-7

Abundant bright white, single flowers bloom continuously from early summer until hard frost.

PINK WHISPER

ZONE 2-7

Small, rounded shrub that produces many buttercuplike flowers of palest pink that sometimes fade to pale yellow.

SANDCHERRY

PURPLE LEAF

A shrub or small tree with pinkish white flowers that bloom in April and contrast nicely against purple foliage. Purplish black drupes appear in July.

SERVICEBERRY

AUTUMN BRILLIANCE

A shrub or small tree prized for its brilliant orange-red fall color and disease resistance. Clusters of fragrant white flowers give way to small purplish black fruit often used in jams and jellies.

SMOKE BUSH

ROYAL PURPLE

ZONE 4-8

A multi stemmed small tree that turns a smokey pink color from June through August. Leaves are showy, turning from burgundy to yellow-red-purple in the fall.

SNOWBERRY

PINKY PROMISE®

ZONE3-7

After spring garden bloomers finish their show, Pinky Promise™ Snow-berry takes over center stage with a flashy display of gumball pink berries that cover the rich mint-green foliage.

SPIREA

ANTHONY WATERER

ZONE 4-8

Flat-topped heads of rosy-pink flowers cover this low, spreading shrub. Attractive new growth in spring is reddish-purple. Leaves of yellow and orange in the fall.

ZONE 4-9

Bright pink, flat-topped flower clusters bloom early to midsummer. Re-blooms in the summer if pruned after first flowering.

ZONE 3-9

Vibrant golden spring foliage, accented by clusters of pink flowers, cools to a yellowish green in summer then a rich, yellowish orange in fall.

LEMON PRINCESS

70NF 3-9

Bright pink flowers clusters bloom late spring through early summer. Re-blooms in summer if pruned after first flowering.

LITTLE PRINCESS

ZONE 4-8

Bright pink flower clusters bloom in early summer. Delicate bright green foliage turns dark red in fall. Reblooms in summer if pruned after first flowering.

MAGIC CARPET

ZONE 3-9

Bright pink flowers bloom early to midsummer. Bright green-gold, red-tipped summer foliage changes to bronze in the fall. Re-blooms in summer if pruned.

NEON FLASH

ZONE 4-9
